Charismatic Cowl



This project was inspired by Charisma Yarn from Loops & Threads. I wanted a thick, tight-weave fabric to ward off the cold, howling Canadian winter winds but also wanted a wee bit of a pattern so it wasn't too boring.

I do believe I have achieved my objective.

Yarn: Charisma by Loops & Threads

Colourway: Northern Lights

Weight: Bulky / 12 Ply / 7 wpi

Yardage: 2 Balls - 109 Yards each (100m)

Unit: 100 grams

Size: One Size Fits All

Gauge: 12 st & 20 rows = 4" in pattern

Needle: 5.50 mm (US#9) Circular Needle (29")

CO 100 stitches and join yarn, being careful not to twist. Mark beginning of round with row marker

Work in K2, P2 rib for 12 rounds.

Work in pattern as follows:

Rnd 1: Knit

Rnd 2: *K1, P1, repeat from * to end of round

Rnd 3: Knit

Rnd 4: *P1, K1, repeat from * to end of round

Repeat these 4 rounds until work from cast on edge measures 7" (18cm)

Switch back to K2, P2 rib pattern and work 18 rounds.

BO loosely in pattern.
